"<u>WORSHIP IN SONG</u>"

(Exodus 15:1-21)

1. MUSIC FUNCTIONS TO PRAISE GOD.

"When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him?" (Psalm 8:3-4, NIV).

"Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray. Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise" (James 5:13, NIV).

2. MUSIC FUNCTIONS TO <u>CONFESS SIN TO GOD</u>.

"Put your hope in the LORD" (Psalm 131:3, NIV).

5. MUSIC FUNCTIONS TO EXPRESS PRAYER TO GOD.

"Lead me, O LORD, in your righteousness because of my enemies make straight your way before me" (Psalm 5:8, NIV).

6. MUSIC FUNCTIONS TO SHARE PERSONAL TESTIMONY.
