1. I must build on God's word.

"Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock" (Matthew 7:24, ESV).

2. I must feed on God's word.

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly" (Colossians 3:16, ESV).

• I can receive it with my ears.

"So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ" (Romans 10:17, ESV).

- I can read it with my eyes.
- I can study it with my hands and with my mouth.
- I can reflect on it with my mind.
- I can remember it with my heart.

3. I must <u>live by</u> God's word.

"Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night" (Psalm 1:1-2, ESV).

4. I must grow through God's word.

"Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law" (Psalm 119:18, ESV).

5. I must act on God's word.

"But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves" (James 1:22, ESV).

6. I must trust in God's word.

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105, ESV).
