"LIE #5: INTERPRET THE BIBLE ANY WAY YOU WANT" (Genesis 3:1-7)

Today we continue our series, *Six Lies American Christians Believe*. The lies show up in what we say and how we live. This morning we consider a lie that has been around since Satan tempted Eve in the Garden of Eden. He asked, "Did God *really* say that?" Can the Bible mean whatever we want it mean? Is truth just relative?

"We are not ignorant of his schemes" (2 Corinthians 2:11, NASB).

"'Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice." Pilate said to him, 'What is truth?" (John 18:37-38, ESV).
