## 3. SAVE FOR <u>THE FUTURE</u> (Proverbs 21:20).

"Precious treasure and oil are in a wise man's dwelling" (Proverbs 21:20, ESV).

*"She prepares her bread in summer and gathers her food in harvest"* (Proverbs 6:8, ESV).

## 4. RETURN TEN PERCENT BACK TO GOD (Proverbs 3:9-10).

"Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. And thereby put me to the test, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you a blessing until there is no more need" (Malachi 3:10, ESV).
