**“The God Who Delivers”**

(Exodus 14:5-31)

*“Joseph and all his brothers and all that generation eventually died. But the Israelites were fruitful, increased rapidly, multiplied, and became extremely numerous so that the land was filled with them. A new king, who did not know about Joseph, came to power in Egypt. He said to his people, ‘Look, the Israelite people are more numerous and powerful than we are. Come, let’s deal shrewdly with them; otherwise they will multiply further, and when war breaks out, they will join our enemies, fight against us, and leave the country.’ So the Egyptians assigned taskmasters over the Israelites to oppress them with forced labor”* (Exodus 1:6-11, CSB).

*“The Egyptians will know that I am the Lord when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the Israelites from among them”* (Exodus 7:5, CSB).
