Popsicle Stick Puzzles:

-Lay popsicle sticks out to match size of picture

- -Place a piece of blue painters tape across sticks diagonally, then flip the unit over
- -Can use clear Contact Paper on picture to help preserve
- -Use glue to adhere picture to sticks (Quick Dry Tacky Glue works well)

-When dry, have an adult slice pieces apart. Put picture face down on cardboard, then slice from stick side with X-ACTO knife. Could use Mod Podge on top to help preserve picture before cutting if Contact Paper not used.

-Great idea to add numbers and dots to back for learning to count

- -May also add names of colors, scriptures, etc on back of sticks
- -Can stack the pieces up and tie with a ribbon or bundle in rubber band
